Subject: Provo Safety Vist

Jesse, you and I and Safety Representative Archie Perez stopped by SJC Provisioning for a brief walk around. We found the following current concerns:

Miscellaneous items

- Truck # 3 second step on rear is bent
- Truck # 2 left side of the bottom of plant form box right behind the cab has dry rotted wood area. Although there is metal over the rotted wood, we recommend repair to keep the trucks in top shape.
- Truck # 7 left side flag for fall protection is missing.
- SJC does not have the new lighter curtains installed on the boxes. All trucks have the very heavy metal chained door tarps.
- Several trucks need the 3 tiered rear steps to climb onto the truck bed. These steps are more ergonomically sound and do help reduce the potential for injury due to falls from the high step up and down. They also help reduce stress on Provo agents' knees.

This is a very short list as we know Provo is awaiting the move to their new facility. We want to congratulate Team SJC Provo for their hard work and their excellent performance by recording no delays for 2008. Job well done to Manager Wayne Campbell and the hard working member of TWU Local 555!
