**Negotiations Update
May 25, 2021**

Brothers and Sisters,

Your TWU 555 Negotiating Committee met with the Company negotiators via video conference on Monday, May 24th and Tuesday, May 25th. Discussions were held on Articles 16, 18, 20, 24, 25 and 31.

Article 16 - Temporary Assignments - The Union and the Company sent counter proposals.

Article 18 – General and Miscellaneous – The Union sent a counter proposal.

- **Article 20 - Grievance Procedures - A discussion was held on the company's previous proposal, but no counter proposals were exchanged at this time.**
- **Article 24 – 737-800 Series Aircraft – Your Union Negotiators presented their concerns with the language. No proposals passed.**

Article 25 - The Savings Clause – Tentatively agreed upon with no changes.

- **Article 31 - Union Membership - Tentatively agreed upon with no changes.**

The next negotiations sessions with the Company will be on June 22nd and 23rd.
