Re: Negotiations Updates

Brothers and Sisters,

Your TWU 555 Negotiating Committee hosted the Company negotiators virtually on Wednesday, October 13, and Thursday, October 14, 2021.

Collectively, your Negotiating Committee and the Company reached a Tentative Agreement on the following article:

· Article 9 - Training

This Tentative Agreement increases per diem within this article from \$35 to \$50 a day. Also added was language for protections on computer-based training.

As highlighted in last month's Negotiating News - 9/13/21 video, Tentative Agreements cannot be reopened unless mutually agreed upon by both parties.

After several passes on these articles over the past few months, the parties have been working through complexities in the language. We continue to make progress.

· Article 6 - Hours of Service/Relief Agents

· Article 15 - Reduction of Force/Severance Pay

· Article 17 - Safety and Health

· Article 18 - General and Miscellaneous

· Article 19 - Uniforms

· Article 20 - Grievance Procedures

· Article 24 - 737-800 Series Aircraft

Your TWU 555 Negotiating Committee will continue to review the Company's proposals, prepare and update our own proposals, and consider the feedback we have received from you so far, including the comprehensive survey results.
