Re: Negotiations Updates

Brothers and Sisters,

Company negotiators hosted your TWU 555 Negotiating Committee on Wednesday, December 8, and Thursday, December 9, 2021.

Collectively, your Negotiating Committee and the Company reached a Tentative Agreement on the following article:

- Article 19 - Uniforms

This tentative agreement simplifies uniform allotment language for all job classifications. The new language makes uniform allowances consistent across all groups and updates the language for maternity uniforms.

We also exchanged proposals on the following articles:

- Article 17 - Safety and Health
- Article 20 - Grievance Procedures
- Article 24 - 737-800 Series Aircraft

After several passes on these articles over the past few months, the parties have been working through complexities in the language and discussing key issues that affect our workgroup. We continue to work towards improving these articles and can report that progress is being made.
