Your TWU 555 Negotiating Committee hosted the Company negotiators on Tuesday, February 8, and Wednesday, February 9, 2022.

Collectively, your Negotiating Committee and the Company reached a Tentative Agreement (T.A.) on the following article:

- Article 17 - Safety and Health

This T.A. memorializes "Safety Check" and "Safety Walk" as two separate events, provides for better communication between the Company and TWU Local 555 Safety Representatives and adds pandemic equipment language.

Your Negotiating Committee and the Company each presented and negotiated proposals on:

- Article 7 – Overtime
- Article 8 – Seniority
- Article 16 - Temporary Assignments
- Article 20 - Grievance Procedures
